19. Peninsula Clean Energy Options for Municipal Electricity Accounts

Interim Economic Development Manager Kathy Kleinbaum provided the staff presentation on the rate choices the City has under the new Peninsula Clean Energy model. Council asked questions of staff.

Public Comment: Adam Lorraine opined in favor of using clean energy to the fullest extent possible.

Council discussion ensued. Consensus was (3-1) to go with Eco Plus and look at ECO 100 after one year's experience in order to assess the actual cost.

20. 2016 Recreation Facilities Strategic Plan - Approval

Paul Council, Parks and Recreation Department, provided a presentation on the Recreation Facilities Strategic Plan. Council asked questions of staff.

Public Comment: Ken Chin, member of the Citizen Advisory Committee, spoke in support of the project, commended Sheila Canzian and Paul Council for developing a process that went smoothly and quickly, noting it is a real success to have kept the recreation centers up and running for 50 years; and the strategic plan gives guidance on facilities for future residents.

Council was unanimous in its support of the plan and its appreciation of staff and the Citizen Advisory Committee.

Motion by Freschet, second by Papan, to approve the 2016 Recreation Facilities Strategic Plan which establishes a vision for the future of San Mateo's Recreation Facilities including recreation centers, community buildings and pools. The motion carried by the following vote:
