CONSENT CALENDAR

Approval of the Regular Meeting Minutes for February 14, 2017

Commission discussed the wording in the revised minutes; two revisions were made. Commissioner Drechsler moved that the minutes be approved as amended. Second by Commissioner O'Leary, and approved unanimously by a voice vote.

2. PA 16-096 Bridgepointe Master Plan Amendment - Adoption of the Resolution Recommending that the City Council Deny the Project

City Attorney noted that staff and counsel prepared the resolution documenting reasons for the Planning Commission's vote; these will be a part of City Council's packet. The applicant submitted a letter, for the record, stating that their planning application was in conformance with the General and Specific Plans. Commissioner Ebneter moved to adopt the resolution recommending City Council deny PA 16-096. Second by Commissioner Drechsler. Motion passed 3-2, Commissioners Rodriguez and O'Leary voting no. Adopted

PUBLIC COMMENT

The Chair opened the public comment period. There was nobody wishing to speak and the public comment period was closed.

STUDY SESSION

3. Hampton Inn & Suites, 2940 South Norfolk Street - Demolition of existing Los Prados Hotel and construction of one new 5-story, 182 room hotel, 89,186 square feet. (PA16-060)

Tricia Schimpp, Contract Senior Planner, presented the project.

Applicant Solomon Tsai and architects Michael Stanton and Steven Allen (of Stanton Architects) were present to respond to Commission's questions. There were no questions of staff at this time. Chair opened the public hearing on this item. There being no speakers, the public hearing was closed.

Commission had guestions, comments and discussion about: The request for the building height increase, site limitations, parking variance, parking study, status of parking agreements with neighbors, deed restrictions, how hotel operations effect parking requirements, traffic and circulation, including ingress/egress, impact on the intersection of the entrance of the Los Prados neighborhood and City of Foster City, location and design of main entrance, need for signage for circulation; traffic management plan and transportation demand management; does hotel shuttle stop at CalTrain?, effect on City's infrastructure, increased sewage flows, pump station upgrade, codified fees and imposition of fees as determined by studies; proposed pedestrian bike bridge overlay will be available next time it comes to Commission, architectural design, including the entrance, towers, and the colors used at back of the building; use and availability of local labor, tree retention and removal, including its effect on greenhouse gas numbers. Commission also had questions, comments and discussion about landscaping, potential recreational use of bioretention landscaped areas, building an environmentally advanced structure, perhaps LEED platinum certified, possibility of all electric building, possible inclusion of vehicle charging stations, water runoff capture and reuse, ambient noise study, position of building and need for visual screening of the back of the market, hotel's visibility from freeway; recommend early work with Hexagon to design site entry, highly recommends citizens in the area engage in this process, wants to make sure neighborhood has a say.

March 6th - City Council will have the second reading of the adoption of the second unit ordinance.
